29th Annual Camden Diocese Charismatic Conference

Fr. Rene Canales (MC)— The moderator of the Camden Diocesan Charismatic Conference, Fr. Rene is also a diocesan priest serving at Our Lady of Hope Parish in Blackwood, NJ. He also serves the Diocese as Parochial Vicar for Hispanics. Born and raised in El Salvador, Fr. Rene came to the US to earn money for his family after his father passed. His calling came at an early age (7) but his situation did not allow him to pursue until well into adulthood. In 1998 he entered St. Charles Seminary and eventually was ordained as a priest in the diocese in 2006. Fr. Rene has a dynamism that can only come from the Holy Spirit. With his leadership, the CDCC is taking steps to revamp the conference to appeal to Catholics of all ages. Fr. Rene's will be this year's master of ceremonies.

Fr. James Blount is a priest of the Society of Our Lady of the Trinity – Georgia Mission. A very gifted Spiritual Director and Confessor, Fr. Jim is a bold charismatic preacher endowed and empowered with the gifts of the Holy Spirit. He speaks of living a life in relationship with each of the Persons of the Holy Trinity, The Father, The Son, and the Holy Spirit. His teachings depict his deep love for the Eucharist and his intimate relationship, love and devotion to Jesus and Mary draws many souls to also fall in love with them. Father is a powerful instrument of the Holy Spirit as evidenced by so many stories of miracles, healings and conversions. His talks help to increase awareness of the intense Spiritual Battle in our present world where evil has waged war against the Sacred thus aiming toward the destruction of holy family life. His humble boldness and untiring drive to minister to the lost and ill are particularly noteworthy.

Dedicated to his healing and deliverance ministry, Father travels preaching and proclaiming the Gospel whenever and wherever he can, in the United States and abroad.

Fr. Yvans Jazon, a priest for the diocese of Camden, was born in Port-au-Prince, the capital of Haiti. Father Yvans grew up in a family of deep catholic faith raised by his aunt where his life was happy and full of joy. He brings us this strength and joy in the Lord with his vibrant, charismatic personality.

After finishing High school in Haiti he felt God calling him to be a priest. He studied two years of philosophy and two years of theology at the major seminary in Haiti from 1995 to 1999 and visited the US on breaks since 1997. In 2000 he became a seminarian for the Diocese of Camden learning English, and he was assigned to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel parish first, then Vineland, St. Margaret's in Woodbury Heights, St. Joseph's parish in Somers Point, St. Peter Celestine in Cherry Hill, St Monica's in Atlantic City and now serves as parochial vicar at Notre Dame de la Mer in the Wildwoods.

Fr. Yvans graduated Immaculate Conception seminary with a BA in Education, a master's degree in Systematic Theology, a second master's degree in Education, and EDS which is a post master degree in Marriage. He has been guest speaker multiple times at Haitian National Charismatic Congress in the US.

Kathleen McCarthy is a published author, Catholic radio broadcaster and has been a Catholic lay evangelist for over 40 years. She is the President of In His Sign Catholic Radio. Kathleen has traveled across the country and internationally as a sought after conference presenter. She has been a guest on my television and radio programs including EWTN and is a retreat director at the Malvern Retreat House. Kathleen has been involved in healing Ministry for over four decades. Her message of the Father's merciful love, the Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist and the power of the Holy Spirit are central to the doctrines of the Catholic Church. Kathleen's willingness to share her faith and wisdom has established her as a dynamic instrument for proclaiming God's Word.

IMPORTANT FOR YOUTH TRACK REGISTRATIONS

PARENTS AND CHAPERONES OF JUNIOR AND SENIOR YOUTH PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

YOUTH REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

- A) Youth must be under 18 years of age and at least in 5th grade level.
- B) Complete the three youth registration forms below:
 1. Parental Permission and Release of Liability - Teen Participant form
 2. Medical information, Consent to Medical Treatment and Release form
 3. Participant Expectations Form
- C) Complete the conference registration form marking the requested track.

ONLY parents or Legal Guardians may complete these forms for each child attending. Forms are available from the website (www.camdencharismatic.org), or call to request them: (609) 522-5010. Forms will also be available at the registration table. These (3) forms must be presented for each child by a parent, chaperone, or group leader at the Youth Registration Desk at check-in for the conference. DO NOT MAIL THESE FORMS WITH REGISTRATION.

For safety and security purposes, children must be checked in and out of any youth track by their accompanying adult. In addition, restroom breaks are closely monitored, so children are to be advised to check in and out with track leaders for restroom trips. For the protection of the children, these rules are governed by the USCCB, Protection of Children and mandated by the Diocese of Camden.
